



Mask Enforcement Policy - Covid 19

Approved by the Board of Trustees August 18, 2020

Due to the high risk of Covid-19 transmission the CDC and NH-HHS guidelines highly recommend the wearing of masks when inside. Therefore, GSAA will be requiring that students and staff wear masks in the building until such time as the threat of Covid-19 has passed.

All students will be required to wear masks except at lunch. Removing the mask and/or refusing to wear a mask will result in the following:

First Offense: The student will be sent home immediately the parents will be notified and the student will be required to attend classes remotely and will not be excused from work. In order to return to the building, they must agree, in writing signed by a parent, to wear a mask.

Second Offense: The student will be suspended for three days and a virtual meeting will be set up with the parents. The student will not be allowed to attend remotely. Students will be given packets with work to do on their own to be completed by the time they return to school.

Third Offense: The student will be suspended for a minimum of five days, or as determined by the DoS. The student will not be allowed to attend remotely. Students will be given packets with work to do on their own to be completed by the time they return to school. After the five days the student will be remanded to remote learning for two weeks at which point the parents must meet with the admin to decide how to proceed.
